

**Wedde Sveg Timber AB sawmill in Blyberg, central Sweden, has recently signed a contract with BRUKS for the delivery of a new waste handling system for its new saw line.**

The sawmill in Blyberg is making a huge investment in the form of a new log sorting plant, new log intake, new saw line and new waste handling system, the latter delivered by BRUKS. Delivery and start-up are to take place in the fall of this year. After the remodeling of the sawmill, its annual production capacity will increase from some 70,000 m<sup>3</sup> today up to 200.000 m<sup>3</sup> sawn lumber.

BRUKS's delivery will comprise bark handling equipment including vibratory conveyors, a Rotom 10-10 bark hog, a gravity-fed type DG drum chipper for the green sorting plant, Tubulator conveyors for bark, chips and sawdust, an SH11 chip screen as well as different belt and scraper conveyors for other transports. Also project engineering, installation and start-up of the entire equipment will be taken care of by BRUKS.

"It sure feels good that Siljan Timber has chosen BRUKS for its new project, and we are looking forward to further cooperation," says Mr Bo Sjöstedt, in charge of BRUKS's project sales for this customer.
